## ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- a) Students passing S.S.C (Std X) examination of the Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination of any other recognized board are eligible for admission to Std. XI. Student passing Std. XI is eligible for admission to Std XII, after passing aptitude admission test.
- b) Minimum 3 -5 students of the total seats of each class of Std XI are reserved for the students passing their S.S.C. examination by Mushtifund Saunstha.
- c) Students having passed S.S.C. Examination or its equivalent examination from Board other than Goa Board should necessarily submit eligibility certificate issued by Goa Board.
- d) Admission to any class will be as per the discretion of the Director (Academics)

## MUSHTIFUND SAUNSTHA

Mushtifund Saunstha was founded in the year 1908. The main activity was in the educational field. Saunstha started Primary School in Marathi medium to safeguard Bharatiya Culture in Portuguese Regime. The Pioneers were inspired by paise fund patronized by Lokmanya Tilak and others.

The Saunstha being old has therefore a rich heritage and over the years it is instrumental in spreading educational, social and cultural activities in Panaji.

The year 1990 has been a stepping stone for Saunstha in expanding educational facilities. It started its own Mushtifund High school in Mala. The High School shifted in new building in 1994 and a middle school was started in Mala. An English Primary School was also started in 1994.

Mushtifund Higher Secondary School was started in June 1995 with Commerce stream and Science stream was introduced in June 1996. Permission for 2nd division in Science stream was obtained in June 2008.

The management is very keen to select dynamic and dedicated team of teachers. The chief objective of the Saunstha is to impart sound, wholesome and integrated Education not only for intellectual development of the student but also to enable him to play an important role in Man-Making and Nation – Building.

The Higher Secondary School is affiliated to Goa Board and imparts instructions in the streams of Commerce and Science. The school functions in the morning shift.

### ARYAAN STUDY CIRCLE

About a decade ago, a student from Goa qualifying in any of the entrance exams to the premier engineering and medical institutes of the country – the IIT JEE, the BITSAT, the AIEEE, the AIPMT, or any other such entrance exam that requires equal competency- was looked upon as nothing short of a prodigy. The state has, in the not-so-distant past, observed a few conservative years without a single student being able to qualify in any of the above – mentioned entrance examinations with a reasonably good rank.

However, in the recent year, with the genesis of the Aryaan Study Circle, Goa has witnessed a phenomenon that could not be more aptly termed than as an 'Educational Revolution'. The ability to recognize student's academic potential and to provide a congenial atmosphere for enabling him or her to exercise it to the fullest is one of the major concerns of any fine educational institute. This ability combined with the challenges of preparing its students to compete at the national level, is something the Aryaan Study Circle has pioneered in the state of Goa.

We, at the Aryaan Study Circle, believe that qualifying for the various entrance exams at the national level is not beyond the ken of any average, hardworking student. Primarily, what a student needs is unambiguousness about his or her goals, motivation to reach those goals, and an unremitting guidance so as to not falter at any level – all of which are the essential ingredients of our approach.

### How it all began.....

The Aryaan Study Circle was established in 2004 by Mr. Vyankatesh Prabhudesai, B.Tech (IIT Bombay), M.E. (IISc), FAAD Fellow (Germany), and the Mathematics faculty at the Aryaan Study Circle. A month's crash course for about a hundred students in the summer of 2004 marked the small beginning of our coaching centre. Our first batch of regular students completed their course in 2006. In the same year, we managed to produce 2 ranks at the IIT JEE. From there on, there was no looking back. The number of our regular students qualifying for the entrance examinations soared exponentially each year. A quick look at the results of the past years is enough to prove the fact that we are assuredly not "All talk, no trousers".

With the vision of exploiting the potential of the student to the maximum, these two top institutes joined hands and floated a new unique unaided higher secondary school named "Mushtifund Aryaan Higher Secondary School" to provide a better ambience to the students of Goa and prove to be immensely advantageous to them in a number of ways.

Firstly, and most importantly, students will no longer have to face the dilemma, which lessons or exams- those taken at school or those taken at coaching centre – are to be studied at a given time; since more often than not, the two are at odds with each other. This institute will provide the students with a tailor- made academic repertoire, so that their focus will now be unidirectional. This sort of an approach to their academics will ensure the presence of a homogenous group of

students, and hence lesser diversions. This would lead to an improved performance – both quantitatively and qualitatively.

The students will be able to manage their time well, since they would now not have to attend separate tuition classes, the institution would look into both the academic needs of the student-

The board exam, entrance exams and also the laboratories. This would especially benefit students who lose out on their valuable time commuting from their schools to their coaching centers. With the starting of this institution, the faculty would be able to organize their activities in a better fashion that would be most suitable for our students.

### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

A student seeking Admission to Std XI/XII class will have to appear for an interview test before the Director (Academics)/Admission Committee along with either of the parents or guardian with following documents.

1. Application form duly completed in all aspects.
2. Original Statements of marks of S.S.C Examination and Xerox copy duly attested.
3. School Leaving Certificate
4. Two copies of identity card size photographs
5. Undertaking in prescribed form. ( Given along with admission form)
6. Photocopy of Birth Certificate

- NOTE:**
1. Once the subjects are chosen by the student in Std. XI. No change in the subject will be allowed in Std. XII
  2. There are 65 (likely to be increased to 72) seats for each class.
  3. Students has to opt N.S.S., Physical Education, Computer Awareness and Environmental Education, Regular attendance and passing in all shall qualify the student to appear for H.S.S.C Examination of Board.
  4. Director (Academics) reserves the right of adding or deleting any of the subjects mentioned above as per the requirement of the institution.

## FEES

- a) Students are required to pay tuition fees of Rs. 9000/- per month.
- b) As soon as admission is granted , the student has to pay full fees failing which the admission is liable to be cancelled.
- c) When delay in payment is permitted by the Director (Academics) the payment will have to be made during the prescribed period failing which the admission of the student is liable to be cancelled.
- d) A student taking admission to Std. XII from other institution has to pay the amount of the required deposits.

## GRANTING OF TERMS

Granting of terms depend upon the fulfillment of the following condition to satisfaction of the Director (Academics) and other teaching staff members.

- i) Minimum attendance of 95% of the days in which lectures are delivered . (Absenting from even a single lecture will be treated as absence for the whole day)
- ii) Regular attendance at tutorials extra classes /school functions/ days of national importance is essential/
- iii) Good conduct and observance of discipline.

## UNIFORM

**BOYS** - Dark Green pant and White Shirt with green colored stripes.

**GIRLS** - Dark Green Salwar and White Kameez with green colored stripes and green dupatta.

## LIBRARY

We have well equipped library with books & periodicals. All students are expected to make use of the library , to foster the reading habit in children.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. School Classes begin with the Assembly which is compulsory for every student. Non attending the same amounts to action against the student which is decided by the disciplinary committee.

Note.: Parents / Guardian are earnestly requested to ensure that their wards reach the school in time to attend the assembly.

2. Every student must have his/her identity card while in the school premises. If the identity card once given is lost the new one will be given with the payment of Rs. 150/-
3. The student has to come to school in full and proper uniform.
4. Every notice issued and rules framed from time to time by the Director (Academics) should be strictly followed.

5. No student shall leave the premises in between without prior permission of the class teacher which may be given in case of genuine reasons.
6. The students should bring a note of absence or medical certificate in support of their absence. They shall bring their Parents /Guardians if informed by the class teachers.
7. The students may be called beyond school timing for the other activities for which students shall remain present.
8. All students are responsible to the school timing for the other activities for which students shall remain present.
9. Every students must appear for every test and /or examination conducted by the school otherwise he/she is not entitled for promotion or filling of forms of Board Examination.
10. Rules of examination shall be strictly followed. Those violating these rules are liable to be expelled .
11. Absences of any teacher should not be considered as free period and student shall not leave the classroom unless instructed. The student shall accept any alternative arrangement.
12. Student must not loiter in the school premises while the classes are in progress.
13. Scribbling on desk, walls, library books etc. is strictly forbidden. If any one found, strict action will be taken.
14. Absolute silence is expected in the school library and laboratory.
15. Students are expected to take care of the School property and help in keeping the premises neat and tidy. Any misuse or damage to school property and help in keeping the premises neat and tidy. Any misuse or damage to school property is liable to fine, penalty and recovery.
16. Collection of any kind funds, entry to the visitors, attending classes other than of own organization of any function or activity etc. are all subject to Director (Academics)'s prior permission.

17. Ragging, smoking , consumption of Alchohol, Vulgar and indecent Dress, Behaviour and Language is strictly prohibited in the school premises.
18. **If for any reason in the opinion of the Director (Academics), continuance of a student is found to be detrimental to the best interest of the school, the Director (Academics) may ask the student to leave the school without assigning any reason for his decision which shall be final.**

### **APPEAL TO PARENTS /GUARDIAN'S**

It is the active co-operation and co-ordination of teachers, students and parents that makes Education a meaningful and productive process. Hence we will be happy if,

4. You see the progress report of your ward after each exam/test.

6. You attend meeting of Parents Teacher' s Association and make valuable suggestions
